






Self, Conscience, Will and Aim

HOLY REMEMBERING



The "self-aware" subject is not final or absolute; its existence has meaning in so far as it **does not become fixated or centered upon itself as ultimate**, **learns to function** not as its own center but **'from God' and 'for others'**...what T.S. Eliot called 'the stillpoint of the turning world.' "Only he will deserve to be called and be in the true sense a son of God who has in himself Conscience with a capital "C".





Buried Conscience

The emotional center is the seat of our ordinary will and particularly the negative part of the emotional center (EC).

The small Will from the change in the intellectual center is not sufficient to control the will of the untrained EC for a long time

The will of the negative part of the emotional center coupled with the will of the physical body forms a powerful antagonist to the Will that is formed through the Work

The knowledge of the Work must become emotional

*In the emotional center there is Buried Conscience...which is awakened when the ideas of the Work have entered the mind and become emotionally felt!




Which comes first?


Man is a 3 brained being; one brain for body, feeling and thinking (centers)




Function = Instrument (car)

and transforming


Real Will

- It is closely related to delight






